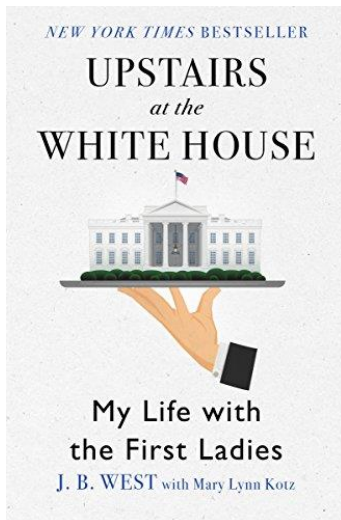


2022 Fall Education Days
